

ORDINANCE NO. 08-03

**AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF
WILDOMAR, CALIFORNIA, ADDING CHAPTER 3.01 TO
THE WILDOMAR MUNICIPAL CODE TRANSFERRING
TAX ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION DUTIES TO THE
COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE ASSESSOR AND TAX
COLLECTOR**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDOMAR DOES ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Addition of Chapter 3.01. Chapter 3.01, "Transfer of Tax
Functions," is hereby added to Title 3, "Revenue and Finance," of the Wildomar
Municipal Code, and shall read as follows:

Chapter 3.01

TRANSFER OF TAX FUNCTIONS

Sections:

3.01.010 Assessment and Collection of City Taxes by County.

3.01.020 Utilization of Regular County Assessment Roll.

3.01.010 Assessment and Collection of City Taxes by County. Pursuant to
Section 51501 of the California Government Code, the assessment and tax collection
duties performed by the City Assessor and Tax Collector are hereby transferred to the
Assessor and Tax Collector of the County of Riverside.

3.01.020 Utilization of Regular County Assessment Roll. The regular
assessment roll of Riverside County shall be utilized."

SECTION 2. Declaration of Facts Constituting Urgency. Government Code
section 51501 requires the City to adopt an ordinance transferring the duties of tax
assessment and collection to the County Assessor and Tax Collector, and prohibits the
City from establishing the offices of City tax assessor and collector. Therefore, the City
Council finds that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, health, and safety because it ensures the continued and uninterrupted tax
assessment and collection by the County within the City, and declares that this
ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption as an urgency ordinance.


SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or
phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the
decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity
of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it

would have adopted this ordinance, and each and every section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase not declared invalid or unconstitutional, without regard to whether any portion of the ordinance would be subsequently declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take immediate effect upon its passage by the City Council.

SECTION 5. Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published or posted in accordance with Government Code section 36933.
